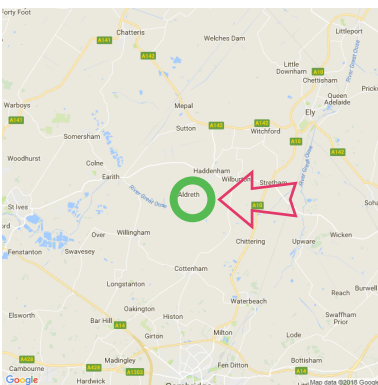
We are in the heart of the countryside between Cambridge and Ely, both steeped in their own history with many surrounding places of interest. The club is owned by its
